Monday, Dec. 9, is a Holy Day of Obligation. This year, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception has been transferred to Monday, Dec. 9. As the patronal feast of the United States, it is always a holy day of obligation. U.S. Catholics are required to attend Mass for this important day. Please plan to attend Mass for the Second Sunday of Advent on Dec. 8 and a separate Mass for the Immaculate Conception on Dec. 9, as one Mass does not fulfill both obligations. Masses will be held on Sunday at 11:15 AM in English and 1:00 PM in Spanish, and on Monday at 11:00 AM in English and 6:30 PM in Spanish.
